


Figure 1. Typical Forward Voltage

Figure 2. Maximum Forward Voltage




Figure 3. Typical Reverse Current

Figure 4. Maximum Reverse Current





Figure 5. Typical Capacitance

Figure 6. Current Derating, Case






Figure 7. Current Derating, Ambient

Figure 8. Forward Power Dissipation





Figure 9. Thermal Response, Junction-to-Case


