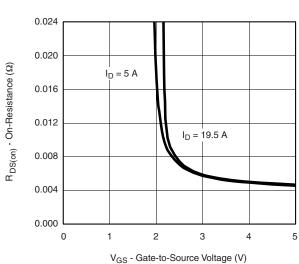












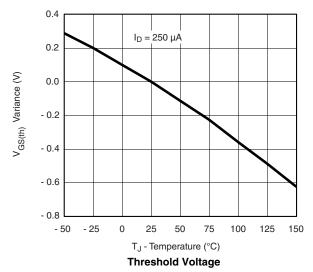
On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

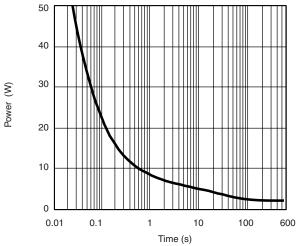

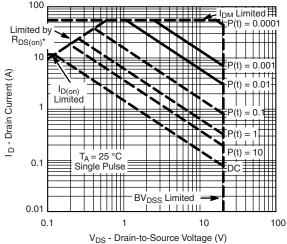

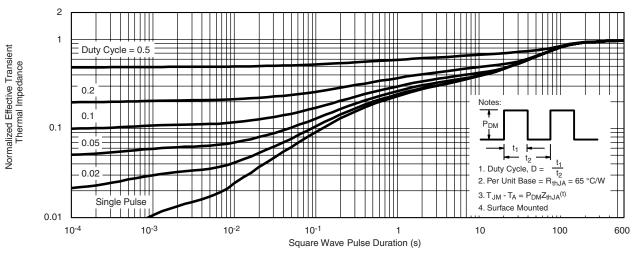


Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient

#### Safe Operating Area



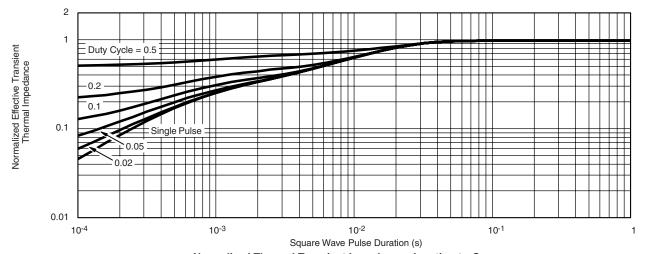
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient
