




Fig.1 Safe operating area




Fig.2 Switching Time




Fig.3 DC current gain vs. collector current




Fig.4 DC current gain vs. collector current




Fig.5 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current




Fig.6 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current




Fig.7 Base-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current

Fig.9 Transition frequency





Fig.10 Collector output capacitance
