For external REF out of these limits see leaflet. ²⁾ \mathbf{V}_{out} is linked to \mathbf{V}_{REF} , by conception the difference between these two nodes for \mathbf{I}_{P} = 0 is maximum ± 25 mV, 2.475 V < \mathbf{V}_{out} < 2.525 V. ³⁾ In Ref_{out} mode at \mathbf{T}_{A} = 25°C, 2.475 V < \mathbf{V}_{REF} < 2.525 V. The minimal impedance loading the ref pin should be > 220 k Ω . Internal impedance = 600 Ω . A protective housing or additional shield could be used.


Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

Remarks

- \mathbf{V}_{OUT} is positive when \mathbf{I}_{p} flows from terminals 1, 2, 3 to terminals 6, 5, 4
- For the EMC, the acceptance criteria are available on request
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100°C.

<u>Note</u>: ¹⁰⁾ Output voltage when LTSR 6-NP is used with internal reference.
